

Accommodation Facilities



Each accommodation block can contain either 4 individual rooms or 4 twin-share rooms. Each accommodation block also contains shared ensuites (one for every two rooms). The accommodation units have been designed to maximise space and provide a comfortable home away from home experience for residents.








Equipped with all the same features, these rooms have been designed specifically for 24/7 operations.



Kitchen & Dining Hall

Equipped with only electrical equipment, the commercial kitchen is more intrinsically safe than gas and has been designed to meet all health and safety standards. This includes sterilisation of all water used for cooking and cleaning.

The dining room has an interior seating capacity for 13 people with an outdoor dining area for an additional 24 people complete with an external large screen television mounted to the side of the kitchen unit.









Utility Unit

This facility provides the backbones of the camp including staff accommodation, a commercial laundry with a large storage room that houses the camp's communications network including satellite TV and internet access.

- Camp is AS:3000 and AS:3001 Compliant
- Connecting leads are fully shielded with self isolating plugs
- Up to 4 fully silenced & redundant generator systems
- Generators have electrical isolation
- Self bunded diesel tanks
- High/Low diesel alarms
